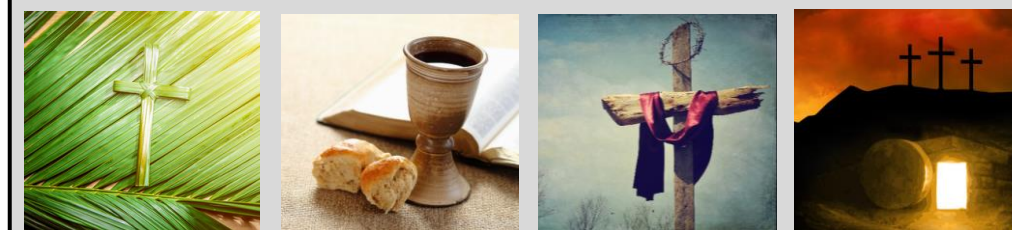
Mary Nelson – prayers needed for Mary Nelson and the family as she is Hospice care.

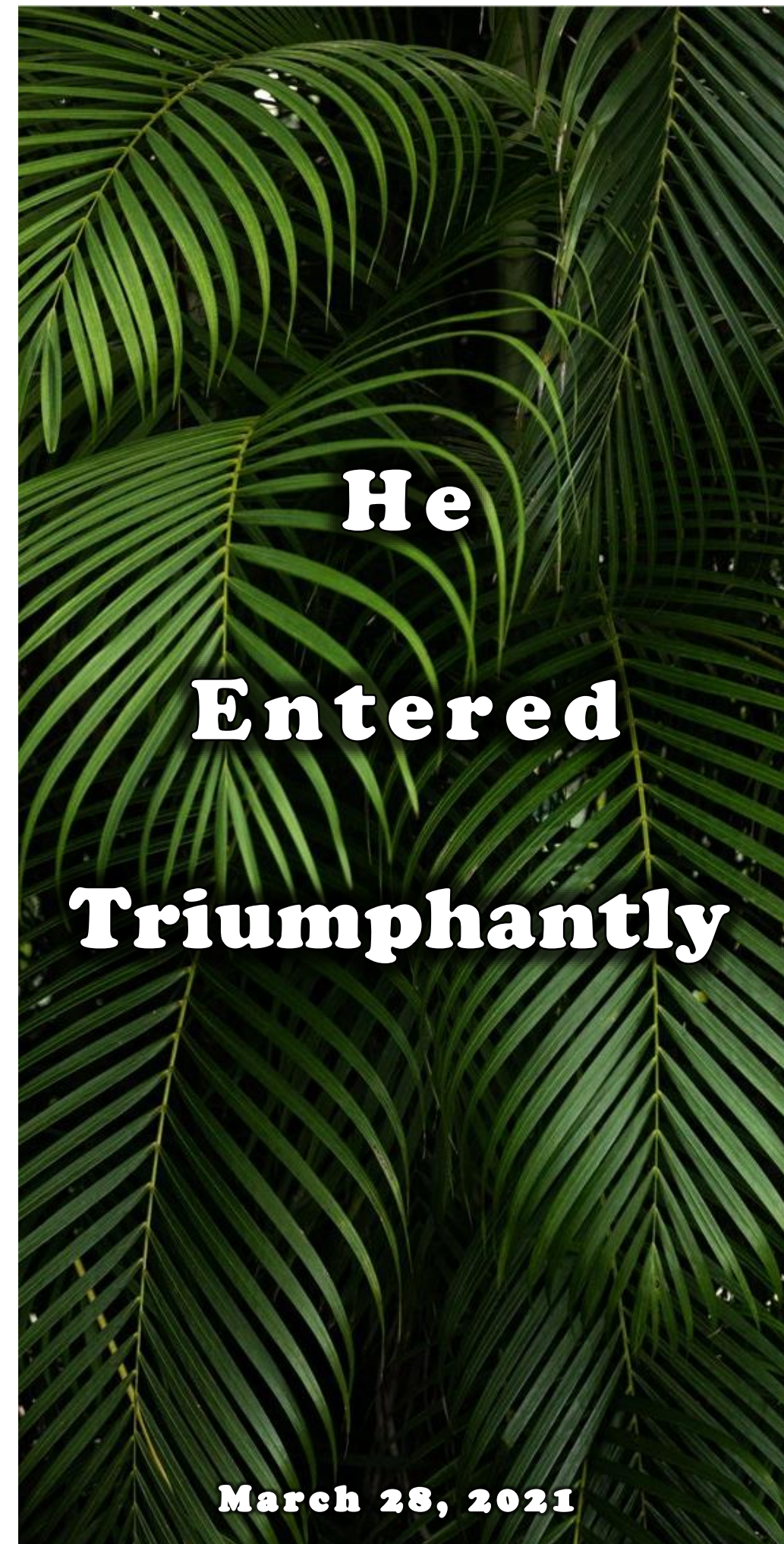
