Amy Martin – prayers needed for Mary Martin's granddaughter as she was having a lot of pain had gall bladder issues which required surgery.

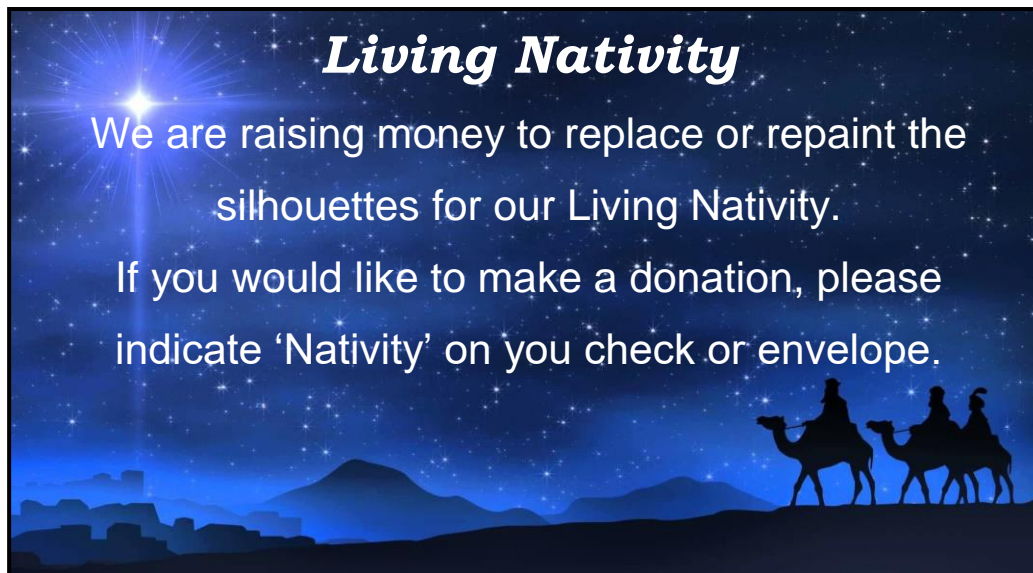
Jim Spiker – please keep Pastor Arnie's brother in law in your prayers. He was involved in an farming accident and sustained four broken ribs.
