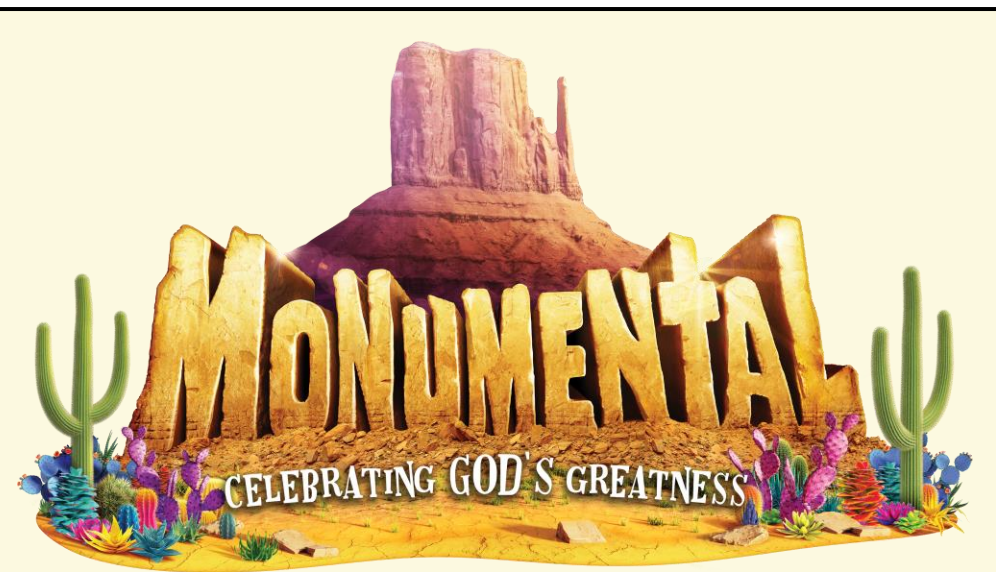

## SCRIPTURE

### Psalm 78:1-16 NIV

My people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth.  
<sup>2</sup>I will open my mouth with a parable; I will utter hidden things, things from of old—<sup>3</sup>things we have heard and known, things our ancestors have told us. <sup>4</sup>We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the LORD, his power, and the wonders he has done. <sup>5</sup>He decreed statutes for Jacob and established the law in Israel, which he commanded our ancestors to teach their children, <sup>6</sup>so the next generation would know them, even the children yet to be born, and they in turn would tell their children. <sup>7</sup>Then they would put their trust in God and would not forget his deeds but would keep his commands. <sup>8</sup>They would not be like their ancestors—a stubborn and rebellious generation, whose hearts were not loyal to God, whose spirits were not faithful to him. <sup>9</sup>The men of Ephraim, though armed with bows, turned back on the day of battle; <sup>10</sup>they did not keep God's covenant and refused to live by his law. <sup>11</sup>They forgot what he had done, the wonders he had shown them. <sup>12</sup>He did miracles in the sight of their ancestors in the land of Egypt, in the region of Zoan. <sup>13</sup>He divided the sea and led them through; he made the water stand up like a wall. <sup>14</sup>He guided them with the cloud by day and with light from the fire all night. <sup>15</sup>He split the rocks in the wilderness and gave them water as abundant as the seas; <sup>16</sup>he brought streams out of a rocky crag and made water flow down like rivers.

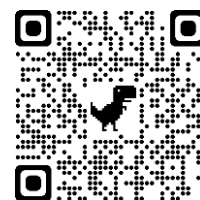
