1 Peter 1:15 But just as he who called you is holy, **so be holy** in all you do;

Gal 5:21-23 ²² But the fruit of the Spirit is **love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,** ²³ **gentleness and self-control.** Against such things there is no law.

2 Timothy 2:19-23 ¹⁹ Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must **turn away from wickedness.**" ²⁰ In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for special purposes and some for common use. ²¹ Those who **cleanse themselves** from the latter will be instruments for special purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work. ²² **Flee the evil desires of youth** and **pursue righteousness,** faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart. ²³ Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels.

Hebrews 12:1-2 ¹² Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, **let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles.** And **let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us,** ² fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Colossians 3:8, 12-13 ⁸ But now you must also **rid yourselves** of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. ⁹ Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices ¹² Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, **clothe yourselves** with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³ Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

2 Chronicles 7:14 ¹⁴ if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and **turn from their wicked ways,** then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
