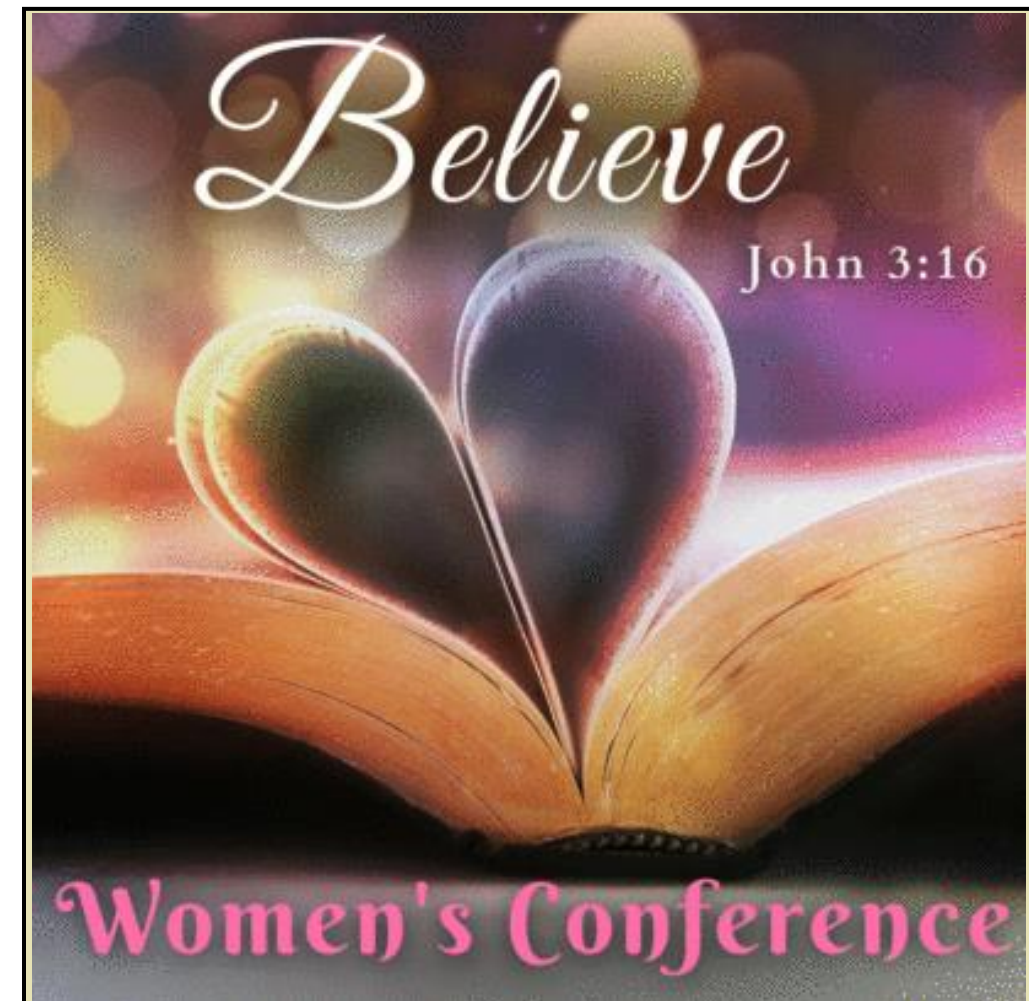
## Praise & Prayer Patch

### Hebrews 11:17-19 NIV

<sup>17</sup> By faith Abraham, when God tested him, offered Isaac as a sacrifice. He who had embraced the promises was about to sacrifice his one and only son, <sup>18</sup> even though God had said to him, “It is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned.” <sup>19</sup> Abraham reasoned that God could even raise the dead, and so in a manner of speaking he did receive Isaac back from death.

Isaac	Jesus
Isaac is referred to as Abraham’s “son, his only son” (Gen. 22:12)	“God so loved the world that He gave us His ONLY begotten Son” (John 3:16)
Isaac asked “where is the lamb for a burnt offering?” (Gen. 22:7)	When John the Baptist saw Jesus, he said “Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29)
Isaac traveled for 3 days on the way to the altar (Gen. 22:4)	Jesus was raised from the tomb on the 3rd day (Luke 24:46)
The wood for the sacrifice was “placed upon Isaac” (Gen. 22:6)	The wooden cross was placed upon Jesus’ shoulders (John 19:16-17)
God supplied the sacrifice to be offered in place of Isaac (Gen. 22:12-14)	God supplied Jesus as a sacrifice to be offered in OUR place for our sins (Rom. 3:25)
Abraham believed that God would raise Isaac from the dead (Heb. 11:1)	Jesus came to die for our sins... and God raised Him from the dead (I Cor. 6:14)

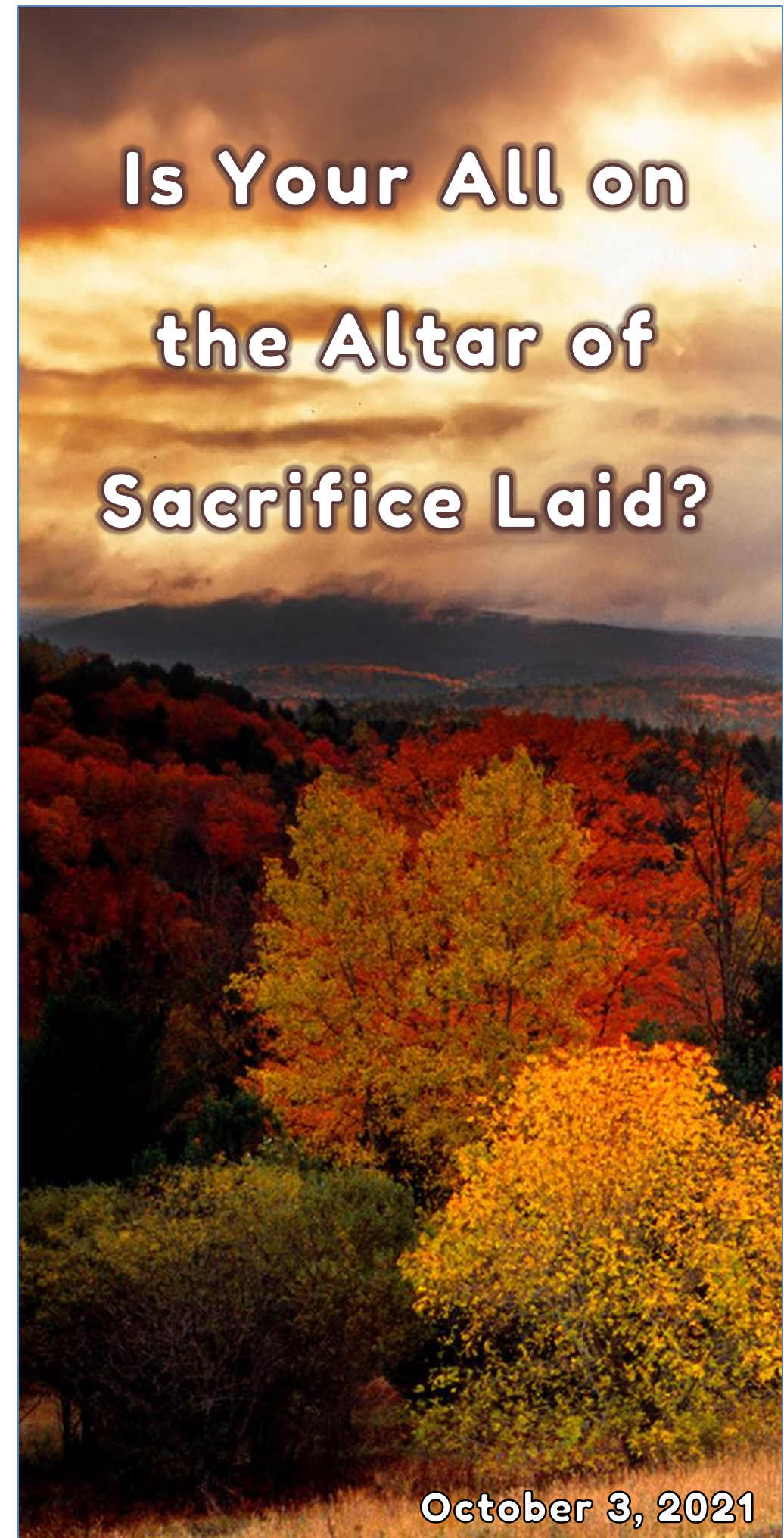
